Chilham is located half way between Canterbury and Ashford, where the A252 joins the A28.

By train: Chilham is 45 minutes from London via Ashford on the new High Speed route from St Pancras to the Channel Tunnel.

It is also on the London Charing Cross and Victoria routes via Ashford and Canterbury.




